The Department of Homeland Security offers training in many locations in person or online for a range of important topics.

Per the DHS website:

Participate in both in-person and virtual training opportunities with experts on how to prevent violence, respond to emergencies, provide support during mental health crises, and support victims of attacks. These trainings can also help you develop active shooter response, build emergency operations plans, and conduct expert briefings to help you identify individuals who may be moving towards violence. Training opportunities are available for the general public, educators, law enforcement, health care practitioners, behavioral and mental health professionals, and for private entities - Camps & YMCAs.

There are several different courses you can choose from. Each set of resources on the website is searchable by keyword. You can also filter the results to see the resources most relevant to different stakeholder groups (key audience) and which department/agency/office provides the resource, as well as filter by subcategory.
